## **Rhodes State Receives Every Citizen Online All-Star Facility Award**

LIMA, Ohio— Rhodes State College received the Every Citizen Online (ECO) All-Star Facility Award at the Connect Ohio’s quarterly Technology Association Meeting held in Columbus on July 20. Rhodes State was chosen based on the number of adults taking ECO training at the facility’s locations, ECO program survey rate, creative promotional and community partnerships assisting in awareness and local success of the program and the level of engagement of facility coordinators in the ECO program.

Dr. Matthew Kinkley, Executive Director of Workforce, Economic Development and Continuing Education said, “Rhodes State is glad to be a part of this community based training program; by networking with a wide range of community based agencies we have been able to provide access to this training increasing the computer skills in our region.” The College has trained more than 400 students and currently averages 25-35 participants per month.

Free computer training will be available this fall at Rhodes State. Registrations are being accepted. The classes are geared toward adults with very little or no computer experience and includes six hours of hands-on instruction of computer basics, such as Windows 7, introduction to the Internet, and email basics.
