This year Rhodes State will join 16 other colleges and universities in the University System of Ohio in converting from the quarter system to semesters beginning with fall semester 2012.

If you are planning to complete your program at Rhodes before fall term 2012, or if you will complete your degree, certificate or course work during or after Fall 2012 when semesters begin, academic advisors are here to help you plan for the transition to semesters.
