Free Manufacturing Training Available in May

LIMA, Ohio -- The West Central Ohio Manufacturing Consortium (WCOMC) will offer the Basic Manufacturing Pathway class May 6 - June 5 on Wednesdays and Fridays from 10am-3 pm. Classes will be held at Ohio Means Jobs--Allen County, 1501 South Dixie Highway, Lima.

The course is free due to the Community Development Block Grant awarded from the City of Lima to Rhodes State College and the WCOMC. Those interested in attending should call 419-995-8353 by May 1.

Other in-demand training has been added to this program that covers areas of lean and continuous improvement.

Curriculum in the Basic Manufacturing Pathway class reflects manufacturers' skill requirements for entry-level employees. It covers basic math and safety. Much of this program addresses workplace or "soft" skills such as communication and teamwork. It also includes resume writing, registering on the Ohio Means Jobs website, and applying for Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to inform students if they qualify for Pell grants and other financial aid for future education they may consider.
